ASSESSMENT

Cambridge International AS & A Levels follow a linear structure with exams at the end of the course, which gives more time for teaching and learning. Many of the world's top universities have made clear their appreciation of this linear approach, and we share their belief that linear courses allow learners to develop a deeper understanding of subjects.

Learners can choose from a range of assessment options:

- Take the Cambridge International AS Level Examination only at the end of Grade 11. The Cambridge International AS Level syllabus content is half a Cambridge International A Level.
- Take a 'staged' assessment route take the Cambridge International AS Level in one examination series and complete the final Cambridge International A Level in a subsequent series (i.e. AS Level in 2025-2026 and A2 Level in 2026-2027).
- Take all papers of the Cambridge International A Level course in the same examination series, usually at the end of the course (i.e. in 2026-2027).
